





(Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs).

They will hold a Fishing Derby starting at 6 a.m. until 4 p.m. with cash prizes awarded. There will also be a Poker Run with the winner announced at 7 p.m. must be present to win. Wheel Raffles plus food and refreshments starting at 1. The big ticket drawing is at 10 p.m. The event will be at Waubee Lodge in Lakewood.

Touted as the longest loop in the snow belt, the trail is groomed with two Tucker Sno Cats, one Case tractor and three Trail Master drags.



Aquatic Invasive Species Under the Ice

Winter has arrived and lakes are starting to freeze. With this change in season comes placing your boat in storage and bringing out the ice auger, tip-ups and shanty. The threat of aquatic invasive species doesn't go away when the lake starts to make ice. When on the ice please follow these rules to prevent the spread of Zebra mussels, Spiny water fleas, Eurasian water milfoil and other invasive species.

- Inspect ice fishing equipment and * Remove attached aquatic plants, mud and animals before leaving the ice
- Drain all water from equipment and containers containing fish prior to leaving the ice
- 2 gallons of water may be kept for minnows * Do not move live fish away from a waterbody
- * Buy minnows from a Wisconsin licensed bait dealer and use leftover minnows only under certain conditions * Leftover minnows can be taken home and reused on the same body of water. Leftover minnows can be used on other waters only if no lake water or fish were added to their container.

Remember it is up to all of us to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species.

Mercury Advisory from **Wisconsin DNR**

Safe-eating guidelines for most of Wisconsin's Inland (non-Great Lakes) waters

Women of childbearing years, nursing mothers and all children under 15 may

Women beyond their childbearing years and men may eat:

Unlimited amounts - bluegill, sunfish, crappies, yellow perch, or bullheads

1 meal per week - bluegill, sunfish, crappies, yellow perch, or bullheads

1 meal per month - walleye, northern pike, bass, catfish, or any other species.

1 meal per week - walleye, northern

(Note: Muskies should not be eaten by this group or people due to high mercury content). pike, bass, catfish, or any other species.

On certain waters more restrictive advice is needed because fish have been found to contain higher levels of mercury or PCB's. Advisories apply only to eating your catch and in no way restrict your fishing or other water activities.
